



Guidelines for Vehicle Use in Central Park

Parking is never guaranteed. It is granted on a first come, first serve basis ONLY with permission from Central Park Operations.

Vehicle Use is Restricted as Follows:

- Production vehicles are allowed ONLY in the following areas: Cherry Hill, Dead Road, and the 102nd Street Cross Drive with advance approval.
- Park Enforcement and NYPD will summons all vehicles without permits.
- No personal vehicles are allowed in the Park.
- Speed limit: 15 mph on Park Drives.
- Vehicles are only allowed on Park Drives following the correct direction of traffic.
- No vehicles are allowed on the Bridle Paths.
- Vehicles cannot stop on Park Drives at any time.
- Vehicles must not block pathways.
- Stopped vehicles must turn off their engines (no idling).
- Pedestrian paths and closed drives cannot be used as shortcuts.
- Use vehicle entrances that minimize driving in the Park.
- Trucks and oversized vehicles must receive special permission to park in Central Park.

Cherry Hill

Guidelines: All vehicles at this location must be pre-approved by Central Park Operations. Access ramps to Cherry Hill are in constant use by horse-drawn carriages and Park vehicles and must never be blocked. In the circular driveway, vehicles must be parked single file on the asphalt only.

Directions: Enter Central Park at E. 72nd Street & Fifth Avenue. Bear left at the second traffic light and continue along the 72nd Street Cross Drive. Just after Bethesda Fountain, turn right onto the driveway leading into Cherry Hill's circular driveway.

Dead Road

Guidelines: All vehicles on Dead Road must be pre-approved by Central Park Operations. Dead Road is constantly busy and can never be used exclusively for parking. All vehicles must be parked on one side in a single file row. Vehicles or production equipment must never block walkways.

Directions: Please contact Central Park Operations for directions.

102nd Street Cross Drive

Guidelines: This Drive is used for authorized vehicles only. Parking is allowed only on the paved surface for a pre-approved number of vehicles. All vehicles must be parked on one side in a single file row. Bikers and authorized vehicles must never be blocked.

Directions: Enter Central Park at 110th Street & Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Boulevard or Lenox Avenue. Turn right onto the West Drive. Turn right onto the 102nd Street Cross Drive (at the sign that reads "No Unauthorized Vehicles"). Park on either side of the Cross Drive, single file. Do not block access to the New York City Police Department kiosk or walkways. To exit, continue east and turn left onto the East Drive. Exit the Park at 110th Street & Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Boulevard or at Lenox Avenue.
